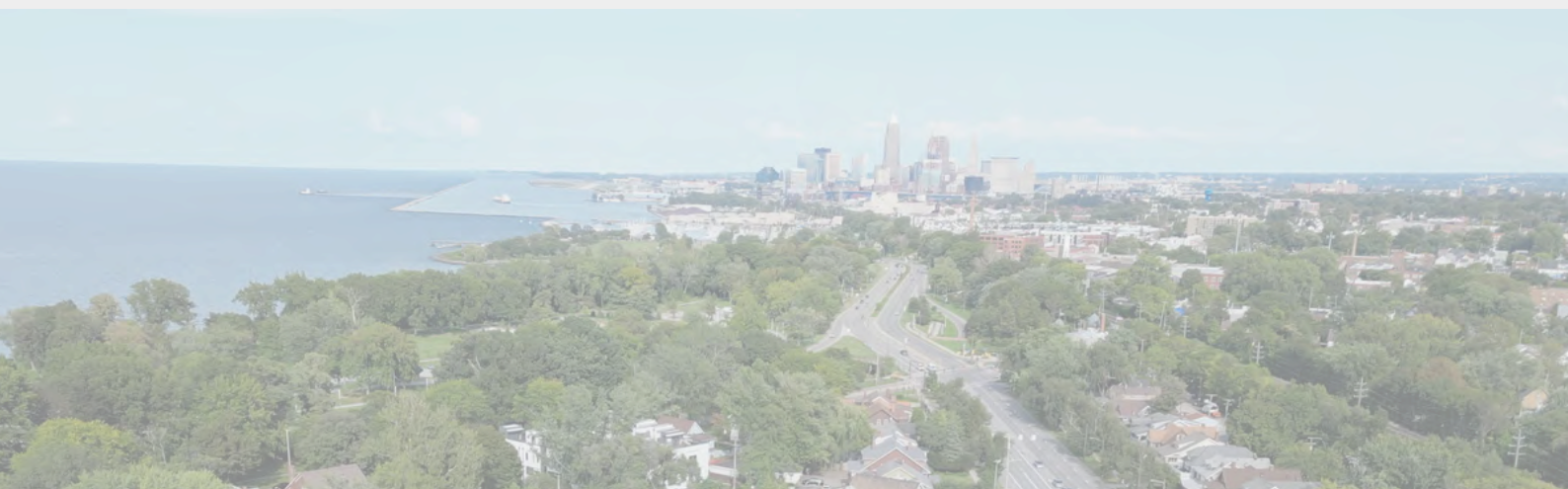
- Increase Resources for Housing Stability

Cleveland 2030: Housing Equity Plan framework: Protect, Preserve, Produce, and Position.

PROTECT

Ensure equitable access to housing resources.

Enable equitable development without displacement.

Protect renters from forced moves and severe rent burdens.

PRESERVE

Invest in the quality of existing homes.

Create and sustain a skilled repair workforce.

Compassionately enforce housing quality standards.

Address the appraisal gap.

PRODUCE

Ensure equitable participation in housing development.

Create a range of housing choices in all neighborhoods.

Create a predictable, practical development process.

POSITON

Invest in neighborhood infrastructure.

Increase awareness of and access to housing programs.

Adequately fund existing and new efforts.

Hold the city and its partners accountable.
