Job title: Community Services Intern

Location: Horizon Administration Office (North Olmsted)- Local Travel Required

Department: Community Services; Reports to Director of Community Services

Terms: Part time- 20 hours per week

About the role:

Horizon Education Centers (HEC) has been providing quality early care and education programming since 1978. HEC currently operates 13 child care centers in Lorain and Cuyahoga counties, as well as a number of after school programs located in the schools. The Community Services Department is a division of HEC that operates an AmeriCorps program, A Comprehensive Literacy program, and two community collaboratives powered by the United Way: Ready, Set, Go... to Kindergarten (RSG) and South Side Pride (SSP).

Responsibilities:

Will primarily be involved with the work of the RSG and SSP Collaboratives.

Duties:

- Monitors and posts on blogs, social media for the collaboratives.
- Assists with outreach and promotion through social media and attendance at community events
- Creates flyers as needed for programs and events.
- Participates and takes minutes at monthly Steering Committee meetings for SSP and RSG.
- Create monthly newsletter for the RSG collaborative.
- Promotes, plans and delivers monthly playgroups for children ages 2-5.
- Plans, assembles and delivers monthly kinder kits.
- Participates in monthly food pantry distributions from April through September
- Ensures that the Pioneer Freedge is stocked and cleaned at least weekly. Facilitates and/or delivers food from local partners.

Candidate requirements:

- Ability to utilize basic Microsoft Office computer applications and social media
- Willingness to travel between Lorain and Cuyahoga Counties; must have reliable transportation
- Knowledge of child development and planning age appropriate activities
