



Paid Student Voter Engagement Fellowship Opportunities through Campus Vote Project and the OCE

What is the Campus Vote Project?

The Campus Vote Project (CVP) is a national nonpartisan project that helps America's colleges and universities get as many of their 20 million students as possible to register, volunteer in campaigns, educate themselves and turn out at the polls.

Fellowship Overview:

Fellows will lead their campus with voter registration, *voter* education, and voter engagement for the spring semester 2021. Fellows will work with the CSU Office of Civic Engagement to help register and engage the CSU community in the election process, and work to institutionalize *voter* and *civic* engagement on campus. Fellows will receive orientation, training, support, and guidance from CVP.

Requirements and Compensation:

Fellows must currently be enrolled in courses at CSU. The Fellowship will start at the beginning of the spring semester. The total stipend for this Fellowship is \$1,200. Fellows will be paid \$500 at the end of the spring semester. If a Fellow chooses to continue the Fellowship through the fall 2021 semester, they will *receive* the remaining \$700.
