CREATE CURRICULUM

- + Combines early clinical experiences with integration of subject matter and professional preparation
 - × Primary (PK-5)
 - × Middle Childhood Education (4-9)
 - * Two areas: Math, Science, Social Studies, Language Arts
 - × Special Education Intervention Specialist (K-12)
 - * Mild/Moderate
 - * Moderate/Intensive

COURSE SEQUENCE

- * Rotations are a five-semester sequence starting in the spring semester
 - + Rotation One-Spring
 - + Rotation Two-Fall
 - + Rotation Three-Spring
 - + Internship I-Fall
 - + Internship II-Spring
- * An undergraduate student taking rotation one in spring 2024 will finish in spring 2026

CSUTEACH


Allows students to add teacher licensure to degrees in Biology, Chemistry, English, Environmental Science, French, Mathematics, Social Studies Spanish and Physics. (students are in other colleges current Arts and Sciences)

- × Adolescent to Young Adult (7-12)
 - * Integrated Social Studies
 - * Integrated Science
 - * Integrated Mathematics
 - * Integrated Language Arts
- × Multi-Age (PK-12) foreign language
 - * Spanish
 - * French

UGRD PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- * All students start as pre-education
- * Meet with an academic advisor in the ESSC
- * 2.75 cumulative GPA (CSU or transfer)
- Completion of 30 semester hours
- × Valid FBI/BCI background check
- * A composite ACT score of 20 or higher **OR** evidence of competency in mathematics and English as demonstrated by:

Math	English
Math ACT sub-score of 18 or higher	English ACT sub-score of 18 or higher
A grade of B- or better in a college-level math course	A grade of B- or better in a college-level English course



BCI/FBI-AVAILABLE IN THE ESSC

- ***** Available in the ESSC on Mon-Fri (9-5). Need payment and ID to be fingerprinted.
 - + ID can be Driver's license or State of Ohio ID
 - + Cost is \$30.00 each or \$60.00 for both FBI & BCI.
- **× STEP 1: Make an Appointment**
 - + Appointments are scheduled in 15-minute increments so please arrive on time.
 - + QR code available at end of presentation
- **× STEP 2**: Pay by credit card upon arrival
- *** STEP 3**: Results are available in 2-4 weeks but typically in a few days.

POST-BACCALAUREATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- * All students start as pre-education
- * Meet with an academic advisor in the ESSC
- **×** 2.75 cumulative GPA (CSU or transfer)
- * BCI/FBI Background Check

P-5 GRADUATE STUDENTS

- * Licensure requirements have a combination of graduate and undergraduate courses.
- * Graduate students must maintain a 3.0 GPA
- * Must earn a grade of C or better in rotations
 - + Undergraduate courses will not be calculated into your graduate GPA
- × Valid BCI/FBI background check

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF ROTATIONS AND PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Students must earn a grade of C or better in all education courses
 - + A grade of C or better is required to move on to the next rotation
- * Undergraduate students must maintain a cumulative GPA of a 2.75 or above and a professional GPA (Education courses) of 3.0 or above

ADDITIONAL LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS

- Students must successfully pass
 - + all portfolio checkpoints in TaskStream to be eligible for internships and to apply for their teaching license.
 - + all required OAE exams to be eligible for licensure
