# I. ADMISSION INFORMATION

The Adult Learning and Development (ALD) certificate program is designed to provide present and future adult educators with theories, competencies, and knowledge that will help them plan, teach, and administer programs for a diverse population of adult learners in a variety of settings, including, but not limited to, technical/vocational colleges; proprietary schools; four-year colleges; literacy, ABE, and GED programs; and training programs within health care, business, and industrial settings. The ALD certificate program provides an avenue for meeting the continuing professional education requirements often required of professional adult educators. Additionally, the certificate program presents a challenging course of study for adult educators who seek further education but not necessarily a graduate degree.

**Note:** New students should apply through Graduate Admissions for Graduate Certificate status in the Adult Learning & Development program. Currently enrolled graduate students must make an appointment to meet with an academic advisor in the ESSC, JH 170, to complete an intake or a program change form.
