### I. INTRODUCTION

The Graduate Certificate Program in TESOL is primarily designed for individuals who wish to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to teach English as a second language in non-public school settings. International students and those interested in teaching English abroad might likewise benefit from the program. Students who want to apply credits earned for the CSU Certificate in TESOL towards a graduate degree should follow the requirements outlined in the Graduate Catalog for the M.Ed in Curriculum and Instruction with Specialization in Literacy Development and Instruction (TESOL). Students cannot apply the certificate coursework toward a TESOL endorsement unless they currently hold a provisional or professional teaching certificate or license in the State of Ohio. For those individuals who seek to add TESOL endorsement to an existing Ohio teaching certificate or license should contact the Education Student Services Center at (216) 687-4625 for further information about other available programs for this purpose. **Note:** New students should apply through Graduate Admissions for Graduate Certificate status in the TESOL program. Currently enrolled graduate students **MUST** make an appointment to meet with an academic advisor in the ESSC, JH 170, to complete an intake or a program change form **PRIOR** to enrolling in these courses.
