Application cycle opens in October 2022. Classes begin in August 2023.

### Why the program works

- Cohort model
- Classes are held synchronously (live, via Zoom) and asynchronously (self-paced, online)
- Small class size
- Course workload geared toward adults working in healthcare
- Students apply the principles immediately in their teaching roles
- Tuition reimbursement available for eligible Cleveland Clinic caregivers
- Financial aid available for eligible applicants
