# Minor in Communication

The Minor in Communication introduces the theories and research methods in the field, while allowing students to select from a wide range of courses to explore their interests. Students take two core courses (Principles of Communication and Communication Inquiry), one theory course, and three electives. The electives may provide skills (e.g. Public Speaking, Professional Communication), teach content creation (e.g. Podcasting, Multimedia Storytelling), or focus on other areas of interest (e.g. Political Communication, Family Communication, Gender). Please see the checklist below for an idea of the wide options available for the Communication Minor.

#### Requirements for the Minor in Communication

Students must complete a minimum of 18 credit hours, maintain a 2.25 GPA across all Communication courses taken at CSU and successfully complete COM 101 and Com 303 with a minimum grade of C.
