

Neighborhood Development Manager – Housing Job Description

West Park Kamm's Neighborhood Development (WPKND) seeks a creative, energetic, and organized Neighborhood Development Manager who enjoys building relationships and developing creative approaches to implement impactful housing projects that support residents. The NDM excels at managing multiple projects and priorities to balance a wide range of neighborhood initiatives including housing repair programs, property management, and middle neighborhoods housing programs. The NDM reports to the Director of Neighborhood Development.

The Neighborhood Development Manager will:

- Manage housing repair programs, including the Senior Home Repair program. Working closely with housing and outreach staff, develop and maintain a robust pipeline of projects. Expand program through creative funding, development of volunteer program, and innovative partnerships.
- Develop and implement strategies for vacant homes and land that could include rehabilitation, engaging developers, or building partnerships with other mission-related organizations. Collaborate with other WPKND team members to ensure robust tracking and monitoring of properties.
- Develop and plan housing related programming to facilitate resident engagement and connection with resources and programs.
- Serve as point of contact and oversee routine maintenance and repairs of WPKND owned property. Collaborate with Director of Neighborhood Development on long-term property management strategies.
- Work with Director of Neighborhood Development to coordinate Middle Neighborhoods strategy to align commercial and housing strategies.
- Support sustainability initiatives and incorporate sustainable practices/climate justice into housing programs.
- Assist with neighborhood planning projects related to greenspace, infrastructure, and business development.
- Participate in grant writing, fundraising, and sponsorships in coordination with other team members to support initiatives and programming related to housing and neighborhood development and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications

- Highly organized with excellent time management skills
- Ability to manage and execute multiple projects and priorities
- Creative problem-solving skills and solutions oriented with a strong capacity to learn new skills
- Experience in housing or related field with a general understanding of building codes and zoning principles
- Ability to develop project scopes and review contractor bids
- Background working with diverse populations and ability to relate to those different from oneself and passion for building relationships with residents and partners
- Strong written, oral, and interpersonal communication skills
- Comfortable and proficient with data collection, management, and reporting and use of technology including Microsoft Office Suite
- Strong ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent work experience in housing, urban planning, community development, or related field
- Willingness and ability to work outside of regular office hours including some evenings and weekends
