

Robert J. Noyce Scholarship Program Undergraduate and Post Baccalaureate Teaching Scholarship Application Packet

APPLICATIONS WILL BEGIN TO BE REVIEWED ON APRIL 15, 2011 UNTIL POSITIONS ARE FILLED APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply for the Noyce Scholarship program, you must complete the following steps:

- Step 1: Complete the application.
- Step 2: Write a 500-600 word personal statement describing your educational and career goals.
- Step 3: Include a current résumé that details your education, work experience, honors and awards, extracurricular events and community activities, and employment.
- Step 4: Current undergraduate students Provide unofficial copies of transcripts from the last two years.

 Post Baccalaureate students Provide official copies of transcripts form your undergraduate degree(s).

Step 5: Provide two sealed letters of recommendation that address your academic achievement and potential for success as a teacher.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To apply for the program in 2011–2012, you must meet the following requirements:

For undergraduate degree seeking students:

- Be eligible to enroll or be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at CSU with junior or senior status
- Be majoring in a field of science, technology, engineering or mathematics (i.e., STEM majors).
- Commit to teaching in Biology and Earth Science, Biology and Chemistry, Chemistry and Physics, Physics and Biology, and Mathematics or a combination of these areas.
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Interview with the steering committee.
- Scholarship support may be awarded for up to two years of full-time study, at the end of which time the applicant must have completed the CSUTeach Program and enter the classroom teaching in a high needs school district. Awardees must also complete an academic major in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science, or Mathematics.

For post baccalaureate students:

- Be eligible to enroll in a post baccalaureate degree program.
- Hold a degree in a science, technology, engineering or mathematics discipline.
