**CEHS Teacher Licensure Post-Baccalaureate Program Admission Requirements**

**December 1, 2016**

The following admission requirements must be met to be granted program acceptance, declare a major (or minor) in a teacher licensure program, and be eligible to enroll in professional courses above the 200 level.

**Admission Requirements**

1. Meet with an Academic Advisor in the Education Student Services Office (Julka Hall 170) for an intake appointment
2. Minimum cumulative undergraduate or graduate final GPA of 2.75
3. Valid BCI/FBI background check
  - \*This service is provided by the Education Student Service Center
  - \*Cost to candidate is \$60.00 (valid for one year)
  - \*Candidates will be required to pay for and complete three or more BCI/FBI fingerprinting checks during the course of their program
  - \*Candidates with criminal records considered by the Ohio Department of Education to be "absolute bars" to licensure will be denied acceptance
  - \*Can take up to four weeks to get results

*It is the student's responsibility to meet with an Academic Advisor in advance of*

**Program Requirements**

- Students must maintain a professional GPA (Education courses) of 3.0 or above and earn a grade of C or better in all education courses.
- Students must successfully pass all portfolio checkpoints in TaskStream to be eligible for internships and to apply for their teaching license.
- Students must successfully pass all required OAE exams to be eligible for licensure.
