Apply for admission to the Levin College of Public Affairs & Education via an intake appointment with an Education advisor, JH 170, at least one semester in advance of desired entrance.

Prior to the intake interview, you must have achieved or completed all of the following:

1. Minimum GPA of a 2.75
2. Completion of a Civilian Background Check for both BCI and FBI.
