CREATE Admission Requirements to Teacher Licensure Programs

Apply for admission to the College of Education & Public Affairs via an intake interview with an Education advisor, JH 170, at least one semester in advance of desired entrance.

Prior to the intake interview, you must have achieved or completed all of the following:

1. Minimum GPA of a 2.75
2. Completion of a Civilian Background Check for both BCI and FBI.
