Programs:

- **Summit County Preschool** provides an integrated, comprehensive preschool program for all students, ages 3 to 5, with special needs or considered at-risk. Related services, such as assessments, speech and language therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and nursing services are also provided.
- **First Start Program** is designed to meet the needs of children requiring concentrated academic, social-emotional, communication and/or behavioral intervention.



Programs:

- **TALK Program** is an auditory-oral preschool classroom where children with hearing loss learn to listen and talk. This program provides an option for families who have chosen spoken language as the primary means of communication for their child.
- **Itinerant Services** include any form of specially designed instruction provided by an Early Childhood Intervention Specialist (ECIS) or related service provider. Itinerant services are provided in the setting where the child, or the child and parent(s) is located, as opposed to providing services at a centralized location.
- **Kids First/TOPS Program** provides an educational and supportive environment for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), and their families, K-12



Departments:

- **Curriculum & Instruction** is committed to providing educators with high quality professional learning and resources, for the improvement of student learning and the development of the whole child.
- **Student Services** provides services to local and city school districts in Summit, Medina, and Portage Counties, and neighboring communities. Services include special education, school psychologists, related services personnel, intervention specialists, educational aides, attendants, and interpreters to assist area districts in meeting the educational needs of their students.



Departments:

- **Human Resources** provides staffing services to school districts in many ways. We can function as the fiscal, payroll, and fringe benefit agent to employ school personnel for any school district in northeast Ohio. The Human Resources Department also acts as a candidate pool resource/screening/referral system for school district personnel to meet districts' employment requests and staffing needs of school districts in the northeast Ohio region.
