



TUBERCULIN TEST

Proof of a negative TB test is required prior to the start of practicum or student teaching for both Speech and Physical Education students. Please scan and email this form to the Office of Field Services prior to the start of your field experience. Submit to ofsassistant@csuohio.edu.

This form can be completed by your physician or CSU's Health and Wellness Services. If scheduling an appointment with your physician, please request a Mantoux T.B. test and ask for a signed statement of the results; this form may be used to report the results.

To schedule with CSU's Health and Wellness Services, these guidelines will need be followed:

1. You have to be a registered CSU student.
2. An appointment will need to be scheduled in advance. Contact 216.687.3649.
3. After the test is administered, you will need to return to Health and Wellness Services 48 hours later for the results to be read. (For example: if the test is administered on Monday, the student will need to return on Wednesday). CSU Health and Wellness Services are located at 2112 Euclid Avenue, Room 205.
4. There is a \$10.00 fee for each test given.
5. The information should be completed below and the entire form submitted to the Office of Field Services.
