

About Our Organization:

The mission of The Centers is to improve the lives of those it serves through integrated behavioral health, primary care, early learning, and workforce services. Its vision is to use innovation and leadership to strengthen the community by providing individuals and families with life-changing solutions to lead healthier and more successful lives. The Centers is the leading Northeast Ohio human services organization that helps nearly 25,000 individuals to build better futures each year. It partners with leading hospitals, educational institutions, and community organizations to respond to the challenges faced daily by individuals and families living in poverty. The Centers operates 16 locations across Northeast Ohio and employs a staff of over 575 skilled professionals, many of whom are thought-leaders in their area of expertise.

The Basic Needs Resource Center brings attention to issues of poverty, unemployment, educational and health disparities which impact individuals and families served by our organization. In the last year, over 1,400 individuals have been served by this program, providing them with the food, personal hygiene products, cleaning products, and clothing they need to live healthy lives. 80% of those served were between the ages of 25 and 60 years old, with a majority being females of color in low economic status. The Basic Needs Resource Center provides basic necessities at no cost. The Basic Needs Resource Center at The Centers was designed to aid in the crisis mitigation process for our clients and community.

Job Description/Project:

As an intern, you will be part of the BNRC outreach team working in the community at our Mobile Markets and regional events throughout the Cleveland area. The position will be based at our 4500 Euclid Campus where you will help prepare deliveries and pickups for clients and aggregate resources between our various locations. The BNRC partners with many Cleveland agencies like the Hunger Network and the Cleveland Foodbank, and you will have a chance to participate in engagement with local partner agencies.

Requirements/Desired Skill Set:

There will be a background check and a training day prior to starting work.

Who is Eligible:

This position is open to all students, and we will be accommodating to your skills, abilities, and schedule.



Compensation:

This is an unpaid internship, but you will have access to resources available in the BNRC. Students will be provided with a letter of recommendation upon completion of commitment.
