ⓄThese values for the number of persons per family differ from the average size of related families (last line second table page 48) for lodgers, resident servants, guests, foster children and wards have not been excluded in the calculations of the values given on these pages. The average number of persons per family is obtained by dividing the number of families excluding quasi-family groups into the population excluding the population included in the quasi-family groups. The average number of persons per family for Cleveland is 3.9, Lakewood 3.6, Cleveland Heights 3.8, East Cleveland 3.4, Shaker Heights 4.0, and for the five cities 3.9.
